# VI Approval of Statistics and Financial Reports (Attachment 2A-E)

# VII Director's Report (Attachment 3A-B)

- Evelyn ordered the seven computers for the HUB as authorized by the Board at the May 3 meeting. This purchase was agreed to when the maintenance agreement with RCLS was approved.
- > It was agreed to wait until the Library is billed by other libraries for resources still outstanding from former Mount Hope and Greenville patrons. These patrons received phone calls in April in an attempt to recover these resources.
- Evelyn reported that the new employee, Kaitlyn Tobey, will avail herself of any tech-related courses available to her.
- > Dick made a motion, seconded by Liz, to approve the Director's Report as submitted. Unanimously passed.

# VIII Old Business (Attachment 4)

- ▶ Dick made a motion, seconded by Valerie, to approve the 2023-2024 budget as discussed at the May 3, 2023 meeting, with overall income/expenses of \$1,310,579, including \$1,143,257 to be raised through taxes. Unanimously approved.
- Valerie made a motion, seconded by Carey Sue, to approve the RFP for Service Plan and Public Notice Ad for solicitation of consultants for the Strategic Plan update. Unanimously passed. Evelyn will send the legal notice to the Times-Herald Record for publication on Sunday, May 21, and post the RFP to the website on Friday, May 19, as well as email the list of consultants on Friday, directing them

to the website for details. She will maintain a list of those who receive direct emails and also of any who present questions, and will prepare a FAQ of such questions for posting on the website.

> Signs have been ordered to prohibit dumping in the Library's trash bins; Ralph has reported no further occurrences.

➤ The Civil Service test for Library Clerk was administered on May 13 with 5 people sitting for the exam. Results are reported to be available in a month.

## IX New Business (Attachment 5)

Dick made a motion, seconded by Valerie, to approve the proposal for bookkeeping services as presented for the year ended June 30, 2024. An RFP will be needed prior to next year's appointment. Unanimously passed.

a reported cost of \$190. Unanimously passed.

- ➤ Valerie reported on the Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI). Two outreach activities involving the Library will be held: (1) the Fall Foliage Festival, in which the Library regularly participates and (2) and a special activity event day (possibly a scavenger hunt) at which DRI members would be in attendance to canvass attendees as to what Port Jervis needs from its Library. This event will be scheduled sometime after the school year is over.
- > The RCLS training schedule has been released.
- > The Reorganization meeting will be held on July 1 at 10:00 a.m. Notary availability will need to be coordinated.
- > A painting of Dr. Bell's will be donated to the Library.

X Next Meeting – The next regularly scheduled meeting will take place Tuesday, June 20, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. A budget public hearing meeting will take place on Thursday, May 25, 2023.

March, May 2023 DASNY I am waiting for current estimates to submit the paperwork for the grant that was initiated in 2018, the money is being held for the Port Jervis Free Library.

**April 2023** The GED is still on pause, any people asking about the program, their contact information is being forwarded to the Ulster Orange BOCES office in Middletown. The library is participating in the Port Jervis Farmer's Market, the opening day went well. It's been over a month that I was told that a donation bin would be provided to the library by Discover Books, I contacted them earlier this week and am waiting to hear back from them. I am still looking through all the policies.

May 2023 I am waiting to hear from RCLS about when the computers will arrive and when they can be set up. I am talking with WALL Radio once a month about programs in the library. The 2<sup>nd</sup> grade walking trip occurred this morning, five classrooms came and did activities in the Henrietta R. Towne Children's Room, each student was given a bag with information about how to get a library card and some promotional items, pencils and pencil sharpeners with the library website on them. I was trying to get Repair Café here at the library, but the repair coaches that are willing to come to Port Jervis are available on Sundays and so the Repair Café will be happening at the St. Peter's Church. I am hopeful things may change in the future and will happen at the library, in the meantime, if they need book repairs, I can offer to do that on occasional Sundays. The application and agreement with Summer Youth Employment Program is in and the program will run for five weeks from July 5 to August 3, 2023.

#### Strategic Plan

There were no more inquiries as of today. Three proposals were submitted by Casey Conlin, Vic Caputo, and Alan Burger. Two others did ask about the deadline and might submit a proposal if we put out another RFP.

## **Summer Reading Program and other activities**

I am adding a lot of programs to the calendar each week and the Summer Reading Program will begin on July 11, 2023, we will have a kick-off with a performer named Jumpin Jamie for kids ages toddler to 10 years. There will be activities and crafts each week for six weeks.
