# IX New Business (Attachment 4)

- Dick made a motion, seconded by Liz, to certify the election results as follows: Proposition 1 (the budget) 84 yes, 16 no; for trustee Dolores Carnosa 94 votes, with six write-in votes, one each for Jack McAndrew, Richard Clapp, Carl Hendrick, Valerie Maginsky, Rosemarie Babey, Matthew Conklin. Unanimously passed.
- Liz made a motion, seconded by Dick, to appoint Evelyn Rogers to the position of Library Director and approve her contract for services for the period June 13, 2023 to June 12, 2025. Unanimously passed.
- Dick made a motion, seconded by Carey Sue, to retroactively approve 2023 remuneration for election workers at \$20 per hour, and to have future rates be the same as County-approved rates. Unanimously passed.

- Liz made a motion, seconded by Dick, to retroactively appoint Katelyn Tobey to the position of parttime Library Clerk with a start date of April 17, 2023. Unanimously passed. It was noted that this
  matter was discussed in a March 21 Executive Session under Personnel. After coming out of Executive
  Session, Dick had motioned, and Valerie seconded, to hire Katelyn Tobey to the position of part-time
  Library Clerk at a rate of \$15.20/hour (minimum wage plus \$1.00) up to 19 hours/week, start date
  ASAP (started on April 17, 2023). The matter was not reflected in the minutes. This appointment is
  made in accordance with NY Consolidated Laws, Education Law EDN paragraph 226, "Powers of
  trustees of institutions Section 7: Officers and employees. Appoint and fix the salaries of such officers
  and employees as they shall deem necessary who, unless employed under special contract, shall hold
  their offices during the pleasure of the trustees."
- > Carl noted that all meeting documents are to be posted on-line no less than 72 hours in advance of a meeting. Trustees will be emailed the board packet and hard copy of the packet will be available to them at the meeting.

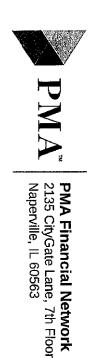

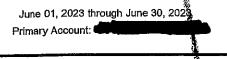

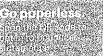

## The Hub

The seven new computers have been installed. Katelyn has been working in the space getting it organized for her to work in the area. Ralph is going to replace the floor because some of the tiles have buckled, he says once the tiles are in, he can replace the floor in a day. There are several laptops, about fourteen, leftover that are still usable, but are not supported by RCLS, I will be asking the staff for some ideas on how we can use them, I thought possibly having a Girls Who Code program, if there is an interest in this area for that. I am anticipating the Hub opening the last week in July and possibly having a grand re-opening in August, if that is necessary.

### The Summer Reading Program

The program begins tomorrow with weekly activities and crafts. Staff will discuss more during the meeting with details. RCLS is hosting a Road Trip program where patrons will travel to different libraries and see what activities and events are happening, our library has signed up to be one of the participants, staff can also discuss that during the meeting.

#### Summer Youth Employment Program

This began on July 5, 2023. We have three students that have been working in the library, I gave them an orientation on Wednesday and had them read several of our policies. They've been working on tasks such as putting books away and shelf reading.

#### RCLS ILS Migration

The network system that the RCLS libraries use will be migrating to a newer updated system, demonstrations have been provided these past few weeks and are being forwarded to the employees to watch. This is an immense project that all the libraries and the system have been working on and either in September or October a decision will be made and is expected to go live in January 2024. Grace wants to make sure the library trustees are aware because of the cost to each of the libraries. As more details are available, I can provide more information, as of now there is still one more demonstration from an ILS vendor that we are all waiting for. The August or September library board meeting, I should have feedback from staff and all the information needed from all the vendors.

# Toshiba and Frontier

Small problems arose earlier this month with both the copier on the first floor and the phone system, workmen from both were on the property and both problems are now repaired.

I am still waiting for estimates for the renovation for the reference room from Port Jervis Electric.

# **Future Programs**
